

- Advocate for policies addressing the needs of vulnerable individuals within minority communities and ensuring access to social services.














# Rashan & Medical Help for Deserving

- Donate unused or un-expired medications: Contribute unopened and un-expired medications to be distributed through partnering medical facilities (subject to proper guidelines and regulations).
